An interactive neuroscience presentation Parachute for students in grades 4-6. Students learn Brain about different parts of the brain, basic Waves neuroscience vocabulary, and how/why it's important to protect their brain and spinal cord. Information will assist student awareness of the brain and the spinal cord, and provide simple injury prevention strategies.

We work with your community to Acchol and Risk-Related plan this dynamic, interactive injury Trauma in Youth prevention program for teens. The

day simulates the difficult journey of an injury trauma patient, allowing students to follow the path of an injury victim. Sessions start at the incident and on to the transport, treatment, rehabilitation, and community reintegration phases. Interactive sessions are provided by local emergency, enforcement, health and other community-based professionals involved in trauma situations.



We work with your school/community to provide brain education that is easy to deliver and understand. Kindergarten to grade 6 students rotate through 10 interactive stations that teach brain function & how to keep brains safe & healthy.
